- Be for recreation, education, or moral enhancement of the youth of this town
- Provide a long-lasting benefit or help to many youths
- Would provide recreation, education, or moral enhancement of disadvantaged youths of Madison
- Help get an important project benefitting Madison youth off the ground (seed or capital money)

Inappropriate projects for the Pardee Fund

- Already funded from other sources
- Provide funds for an operating budget
- Do not benefit Madison youth
- Support a political or religious agenda (although a youth project for a mission trip by a church to build homes for the poor would be acceptable if proselytizing was not part of the program)
